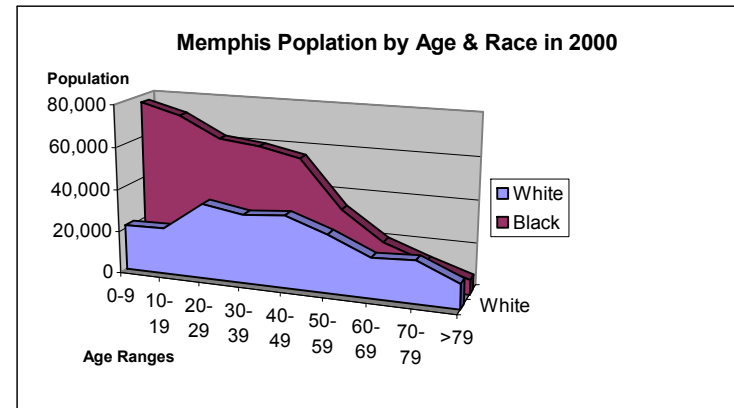

**INCOME & POVERTY LEVELS (CITY OF MEMPHIS)**



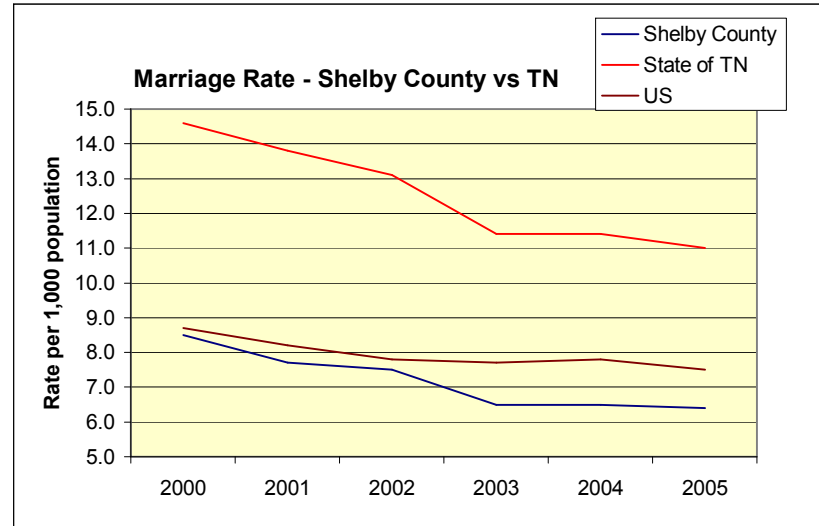
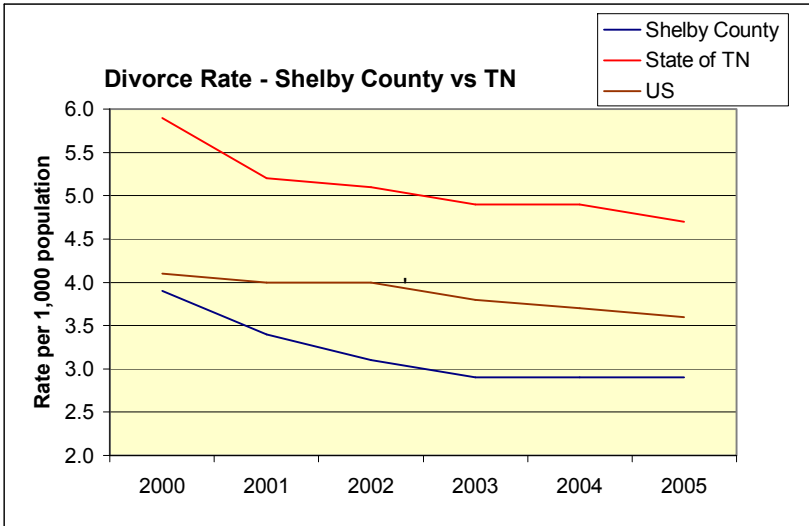

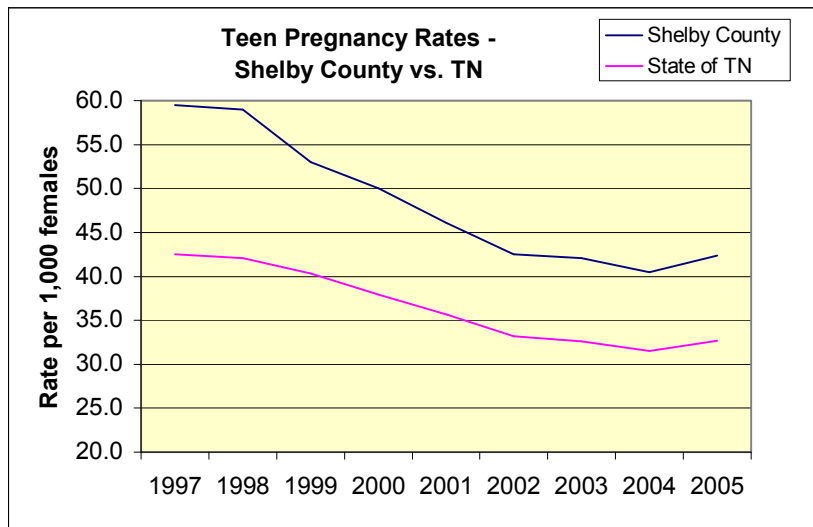
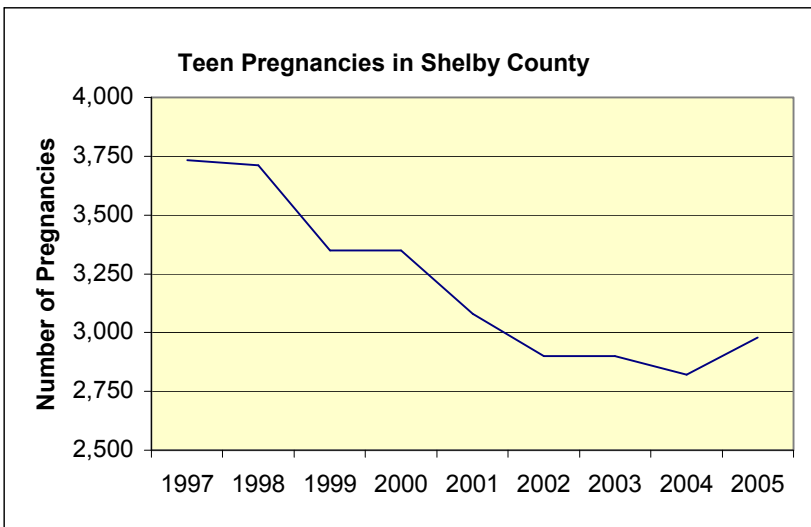
The Shelby County divorce rate is among the lowest in the state and below the national rate....but so is the marriage rate



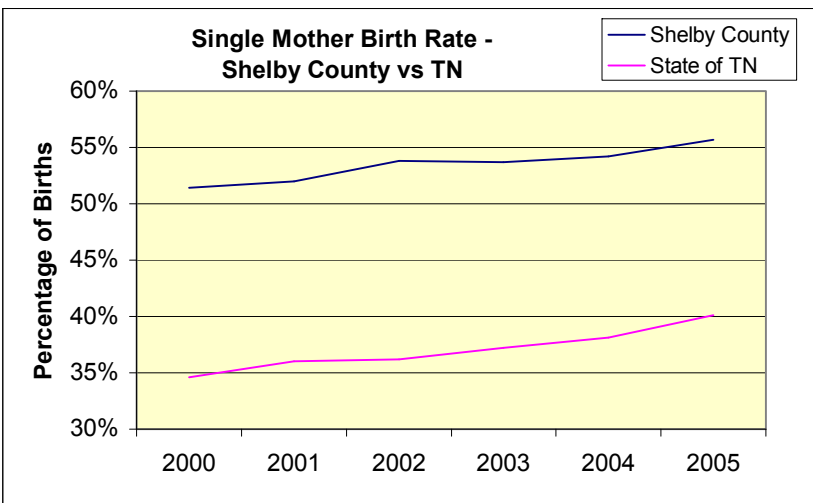
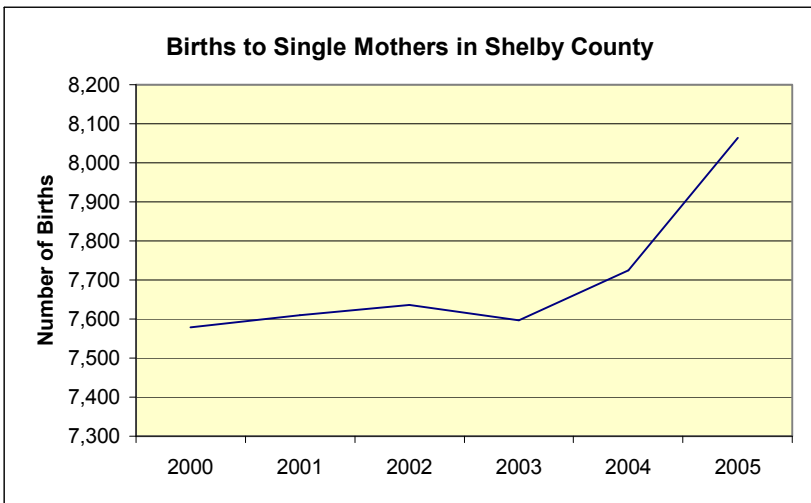
Pregnancies & abortions in Shelby County have declined moderately...but the abortion rate ticked up in 2005

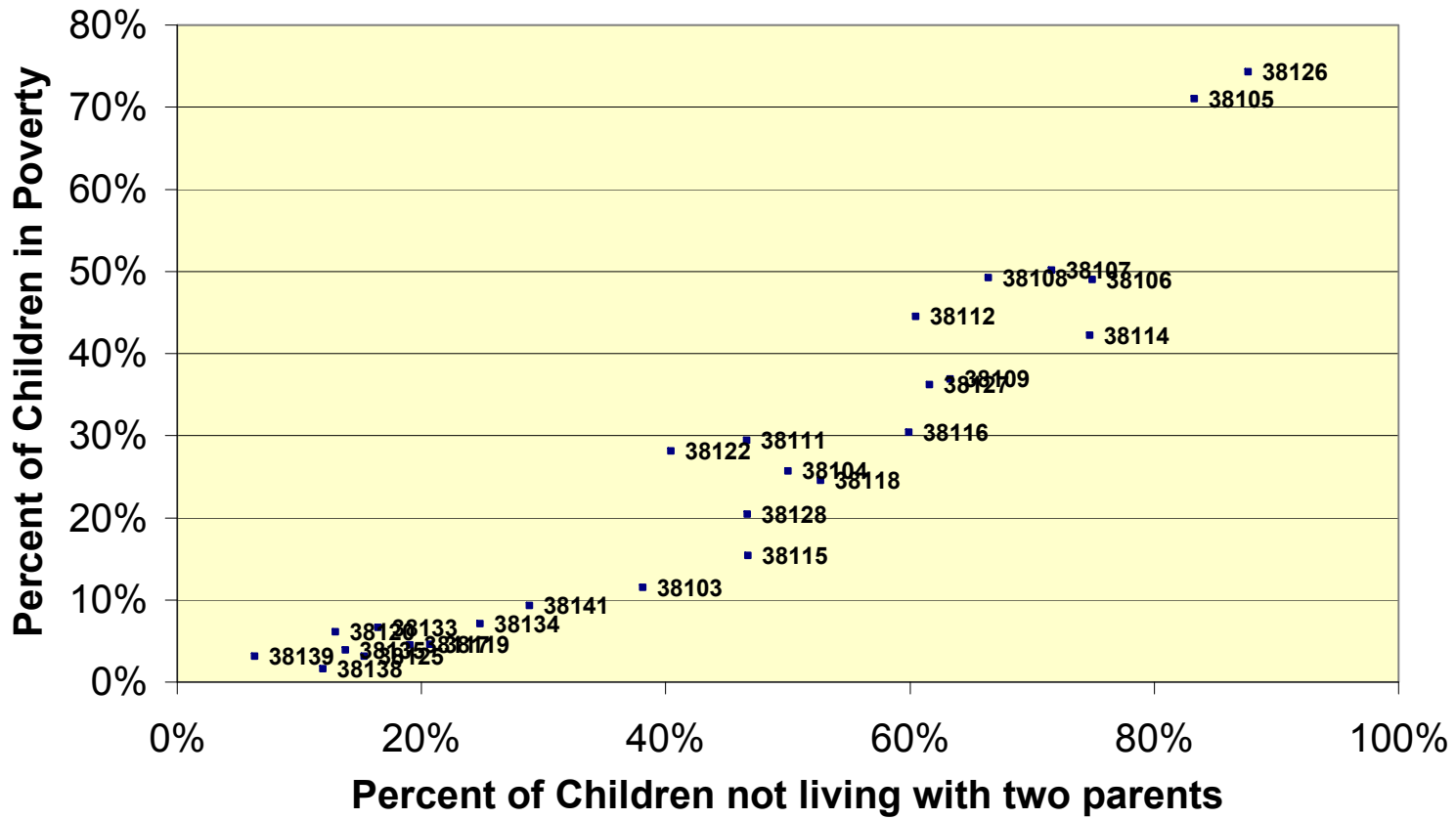

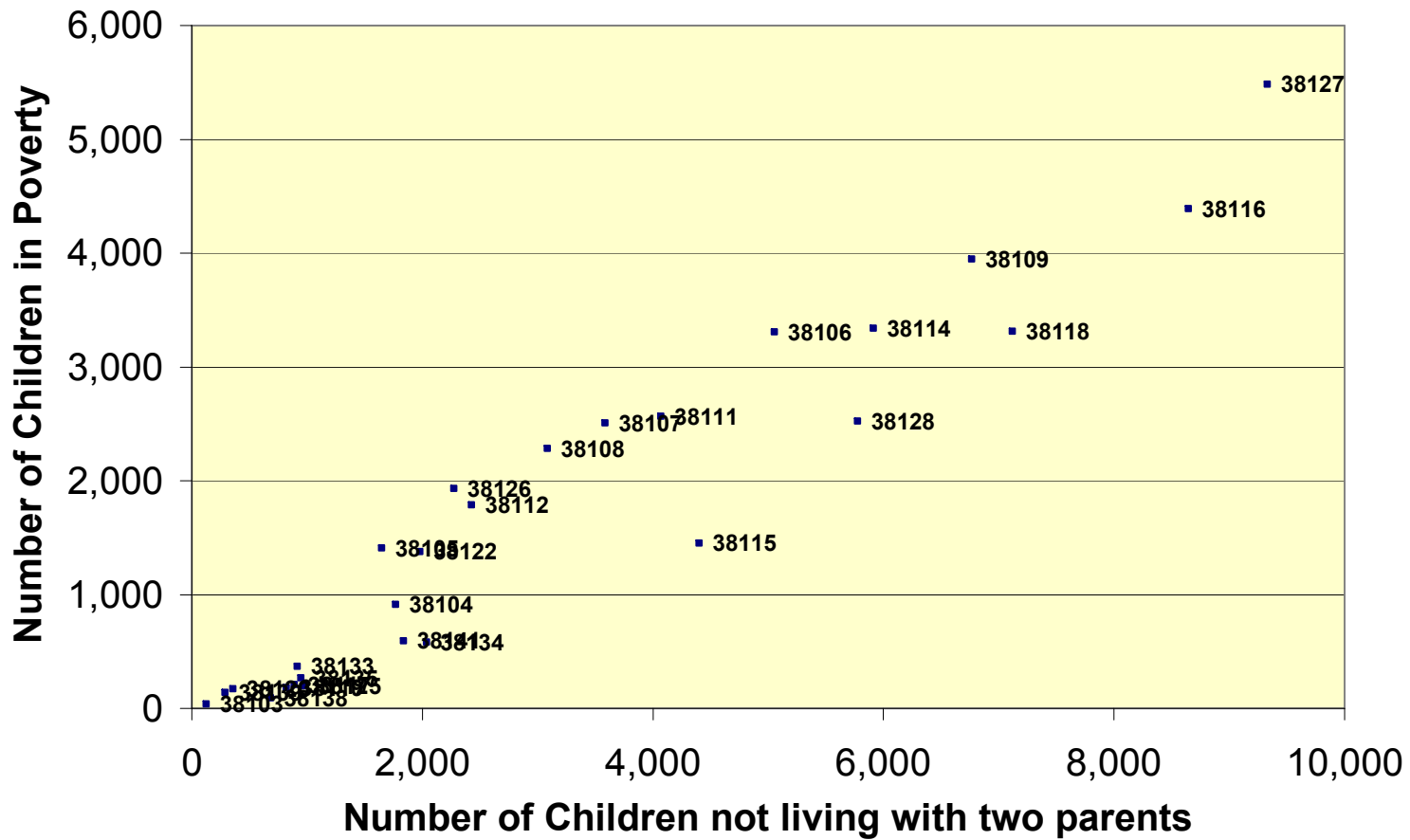


## Child Poverty Rate vs. Percent of Children Living with two Parents by Zip Code in Shelby County

## Number of Children in Poverty vs. Number of Not Living with two Parente by Zip Code in Shelby County

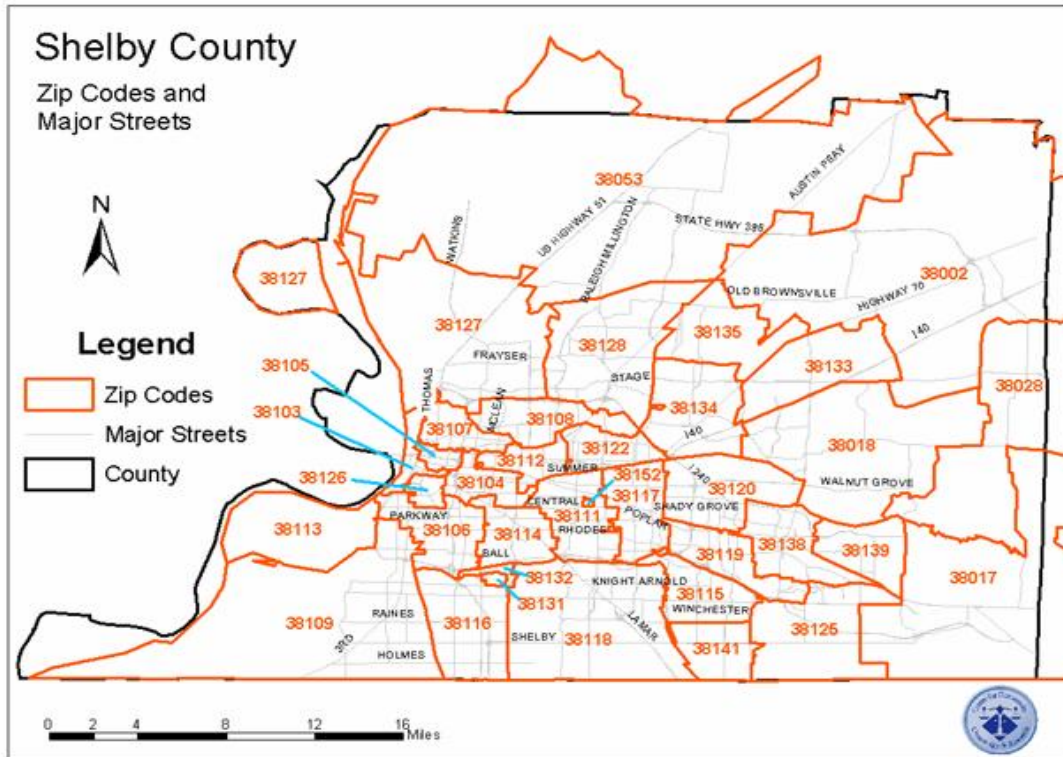
