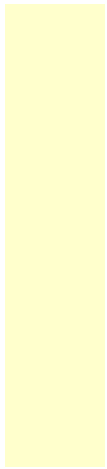

TRENDS IN MARRIAGE, DIVORCE, SINGLE MOTHER BIRTHS & ABORTIONS**

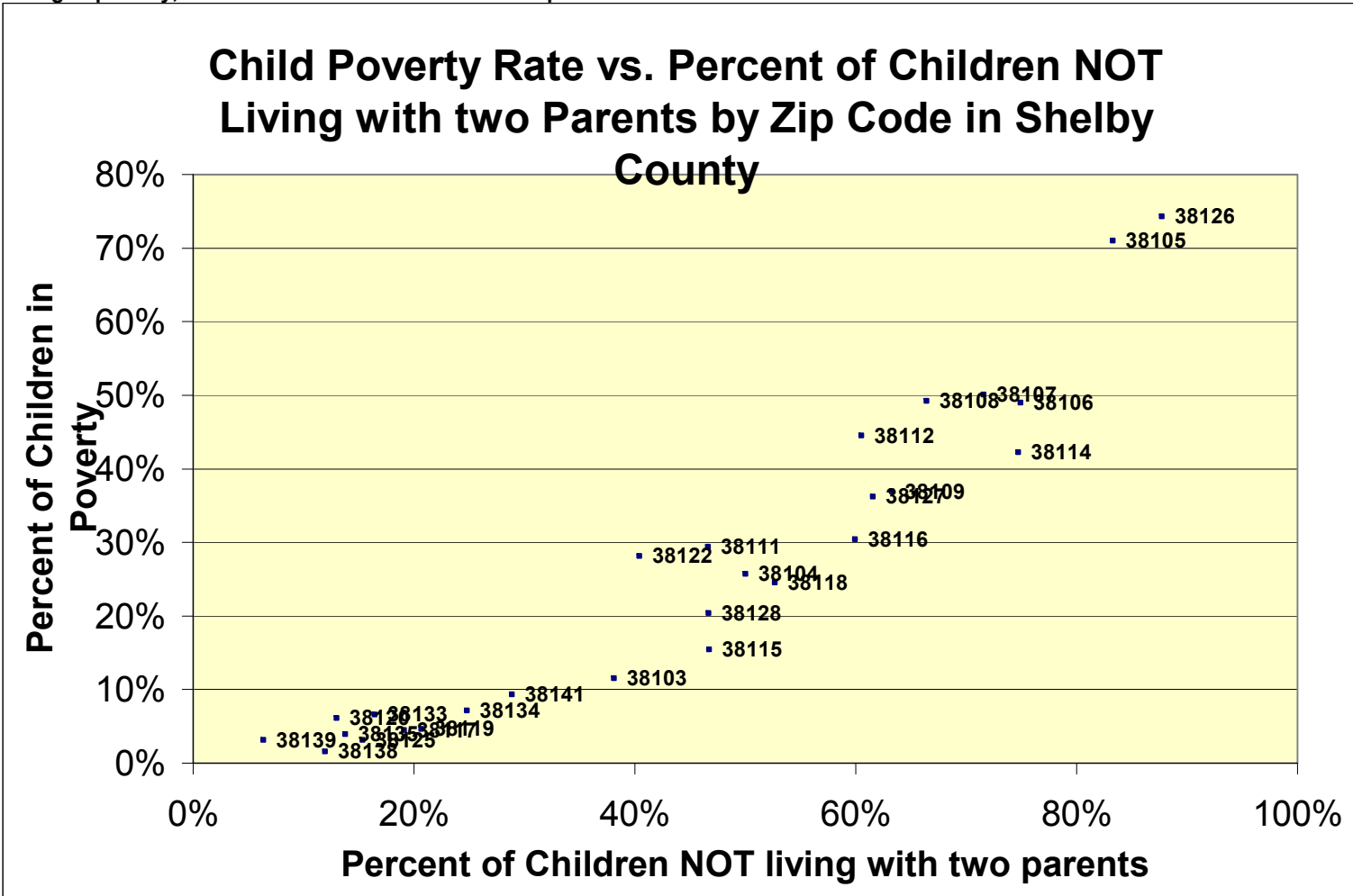
Shelby County does not have a divorce problem. It has a marriage problem with a marriage rate below state and national levels:



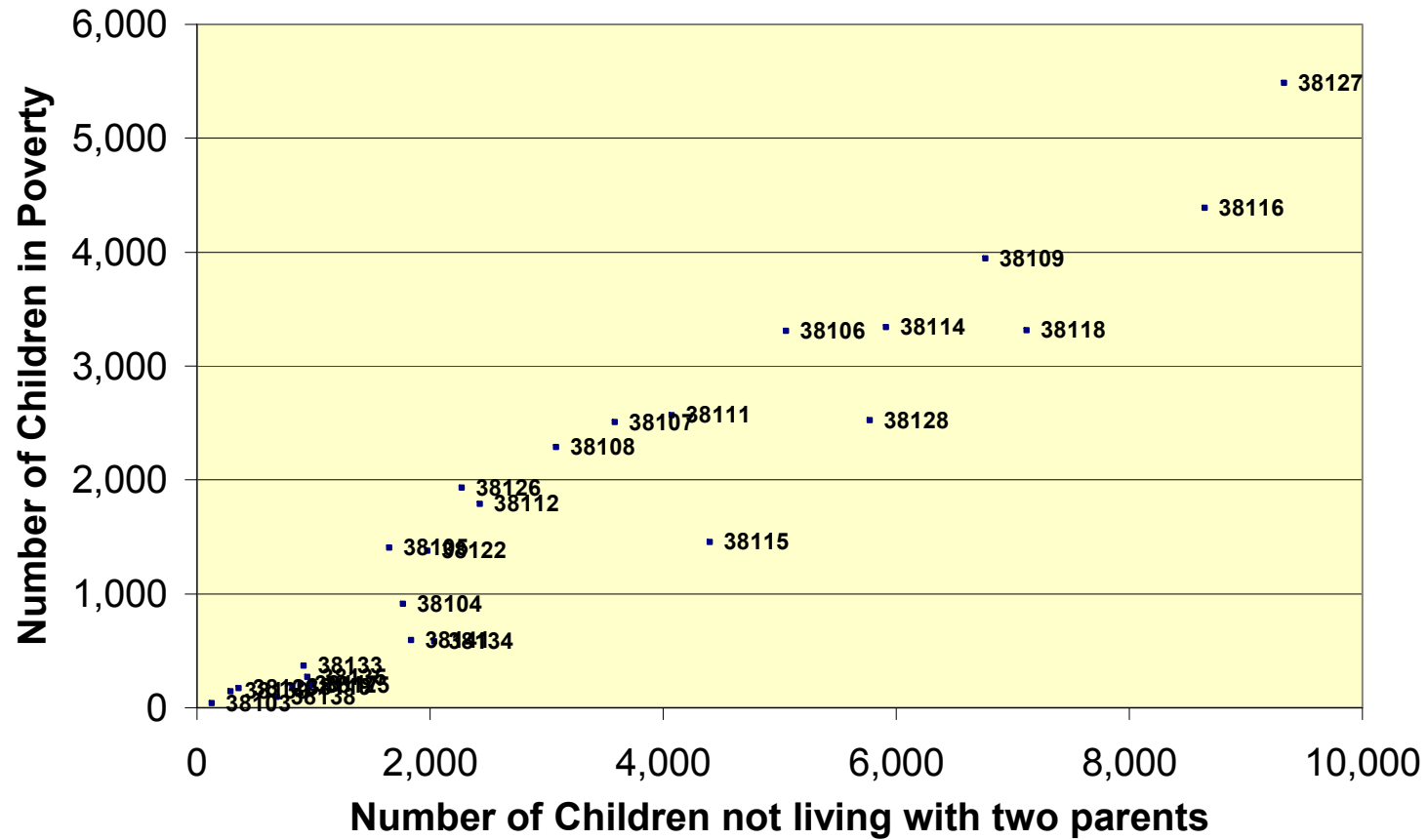
Falling rates of marriage are reflected in an increasing number of births to single mothers:

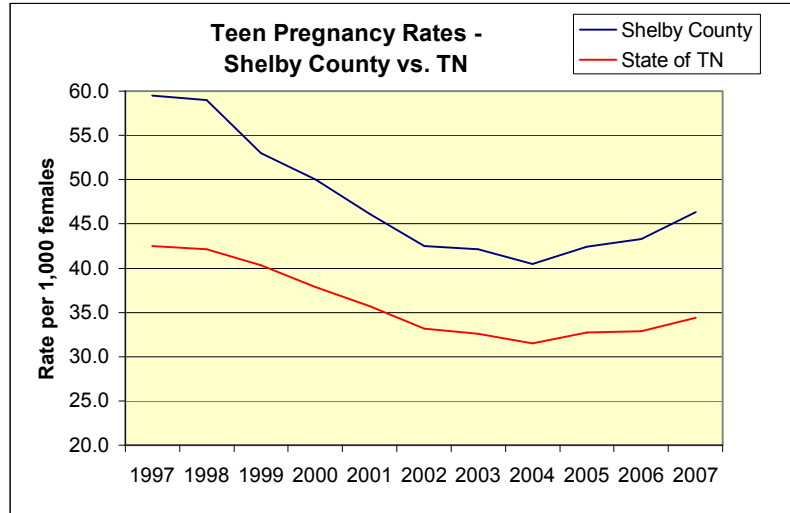
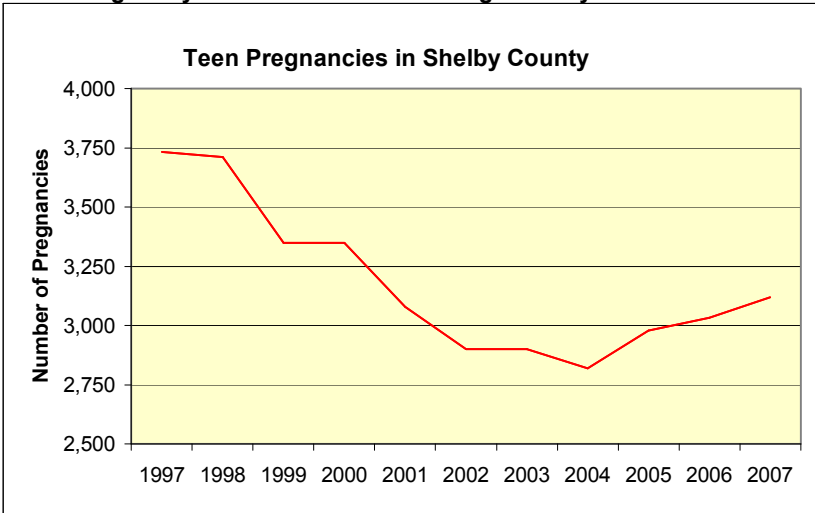


Number of Children in Poverty vs. Number of Not Living with two Parents by Zip Code in Shelby County

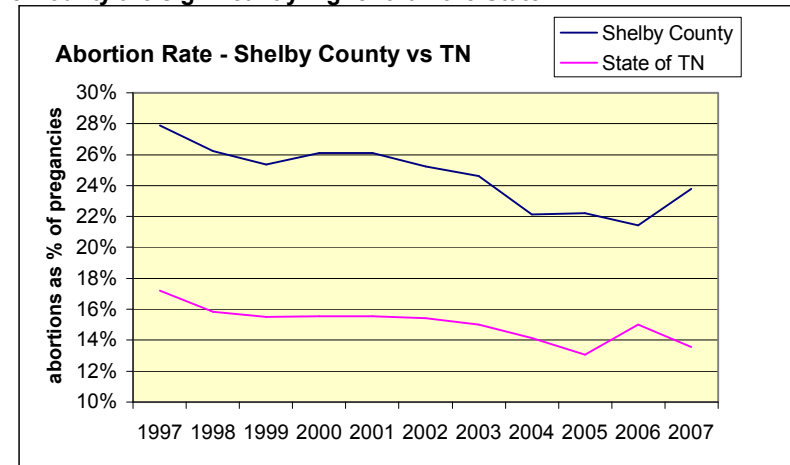
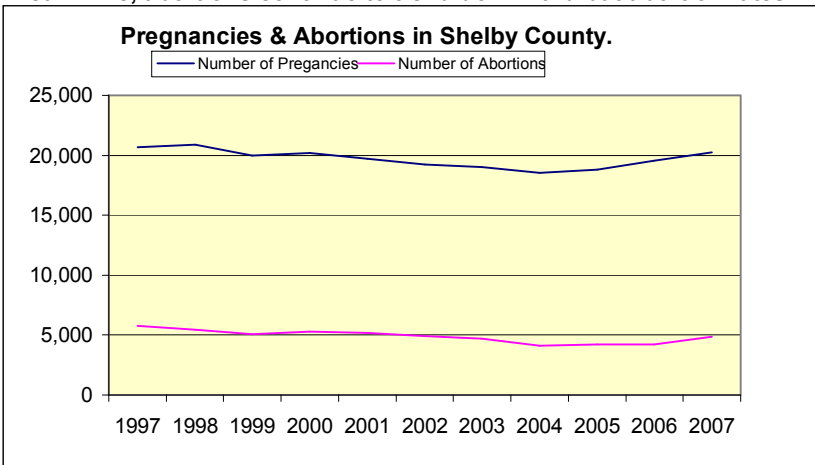


TRENDS IN TEEN PREGNANCIES AND ABORTIONS
